Blackberry Hill is a warm and inviting **residential care home**, set in the small village of Castle Cary, Somerset. Here, we provide **high-quality, 24-hour support for 10 people** with complex learning disabilities, Angelman syndrome, autism and epilepsy.

The home has 10 fully-furnished **en-suite bedrooms**. Neutrally decorated, they are ready to be personalised to reflect individual tastes and preferences.

We use a **person-centred** approach to meeting the wellbeing outcomes of each individual, supporting them to engage in a range of activities at home and in the community. These include arts and crafts in our conservatory, pamper sessions and **sensory or music room** sessions.

The people we support also get involved in social activities, such as horse riding, music sessions, exercise and hydrotherapy - **the opportunities are endless!**





## A place to call home

Our home has been adapted for those with additional mobility needs. The first floor is **accessible by lift**, and all our bathrooms are complete with **grab-bars**.

Housemates share other communal areas within the property, including a spacious lounge, dedicated sensory room, dining room and a kitchen, where they cook and learn independent living skills.

We love to be **part of the local community** and enjoy attending local fetes and markets, or visiting the cinema, cafés, pubs, restaurants and other beautiful spots in our surrounding areas.

Our experienced and friendly team are trained with intensive interaction skills, and can support individuals with specialist communication or dietary needs.

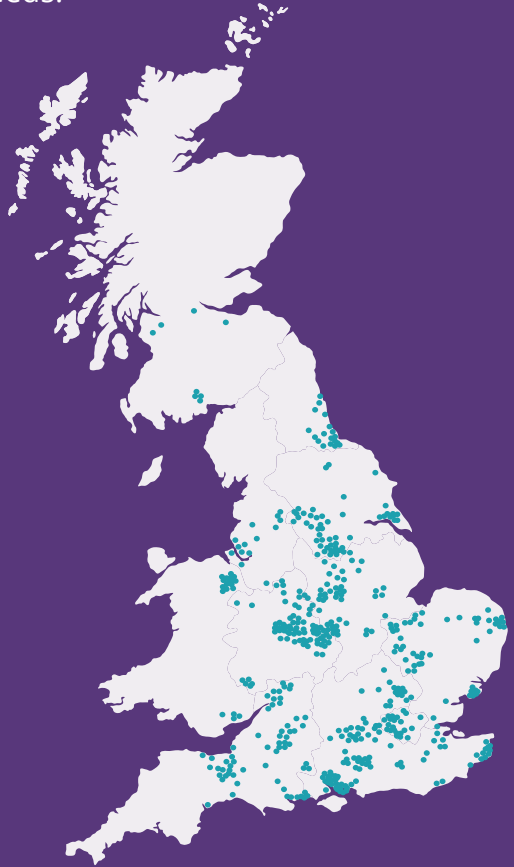
