Our spacious bungalow features 10 bedrooms with height adjustable beds. We have lots of **shared communal areas**, including two large living rooms, a kitchen and dining room - perfect for taking part in activities with other housemates.

Need stimulation? We've also got a **sensory room** with fibre optic lights, ball pool and sensory items - or simply find a space to sit back and relax!

Our home benefits from an **indoor swimming pool**, ideal for hydrotherapy or simply for the people we support to enjoy. Both our indoor swimming pool and sensory room are fitted with tracking hoists to support those with mobility issues.

Our home offers bespoke activities tailored to meet the needs of the people we support. To assist with accessing community activities, we have an **on-site vehicle** that can occupy those using a wheelchair.

Throughout the year, we host **different theme days** where the people we support can dress up and enjoy fun activities. Some of these themes include, “wear odd socks day”, Halloween, Easter, Christmas and many more!

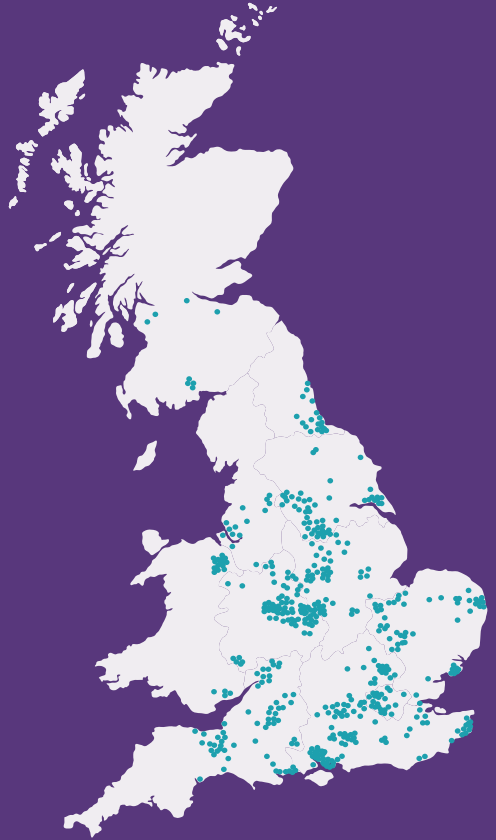
