Our home features one bedroom on the ground floor and four additional bedrooms located upstairs in the main building. Each bedroom is equipped with an **en-suite bathroom for convenience and privacy**. Our shared communal areas include a spacious kitchen, an open-plan dining room and living room - perfect for socialising!

We have **an annex** which has its own lounge/bedroom, kitchen and bathroom, and can be accessed externally.

Our **large garden** has a trampoline, swing and paddling pool for summer fun. The garden also features a sensory wall and space for sports like football or basketball.

Our home has a **sensory room** on the ground floor, designed to stimulate the senses and enhance the wellbeing of our housemates. We also offer a **variety of activities** such as baking, arts and crafts, music listening, pamper sessions and movie nights.

For those interested in going out, we **arrange daily outings** including swimming, walking, cinema visits, shopping trips, bowling and dining out. We plan an **annual holiday** for each person we support, typically to a caravan park, though we are open to other destinations depending on individual preferences.
