Our **spacious**, **detached home** features three bedrooms on the ground floor, with the remaining rooms on the first floor. Each bedroom has a wash basin for personal care. There are two wet rooms on the ground and first floor, alongside additional communal bathrooms.

We have lots of **shared communal areas**, including two lounges, a dining room and kitchen – perfect for the people we support to learn independent living skills. Our home is comfortable and easily accessible, with a **lift and ramps for wheelchair users**.

At the rear of the property, we have two gardens. One space is being developed to **encourage wildlife**, and the other has a lovely patio area where the people we support can engage in activities and parties!


