Calvert House is a **residential care home** located in Preston, Lancashire. We provide **support for up to eight people** with brain injury rehabilitation, brain injury non-rehabilitation, challenging behaviour, learning and physical disabilities, and mental health needs.

Our home is **accessible for wheelchair users**, and features ceiling track hoists. Each of our eight apartments can be personalised to the individual's preferences and include a spacious living area, bedroom and en-suite facilities.

Most apartments have a **separate kitchen** for meal preparation, perfect for greater independence. The apartments are spread across two floors, and there's a lift located on the second floor - great for those with mobility needs!

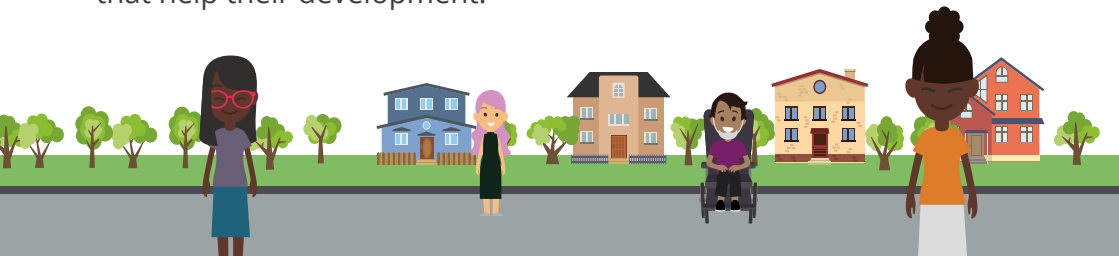


## A place to call home

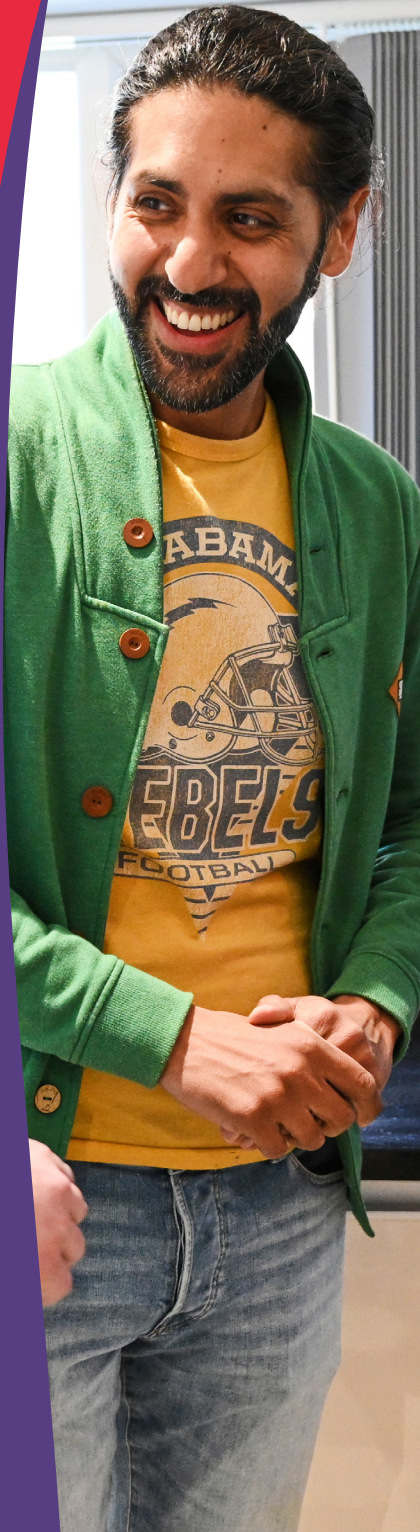

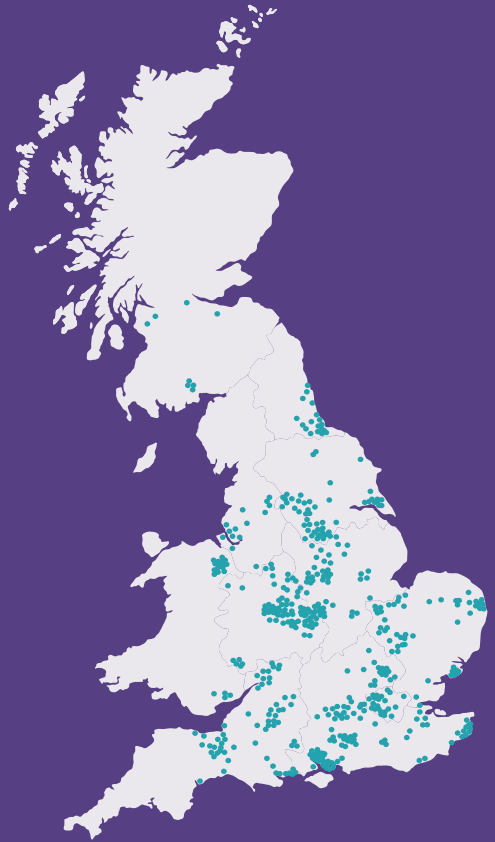
