Our **detached home** has four bedrooms - one with en-suite facilities. There's a wet room located on the ground floor, and a shared bathroom on the first floor, which features a bath and walk in shower - great for personal care needs.

Titchfield Lodge has **shared communal areas** such as a lounge, sensory room, kitchen and a beautiful spacious garden.

We are **close to many local amenities and attractions**, such as the retail park, Lee-on-the solent beach, Titchfield Abbey, the River Hamble and Whiteley shopping centre, which has a cinema and a range of restaurants!

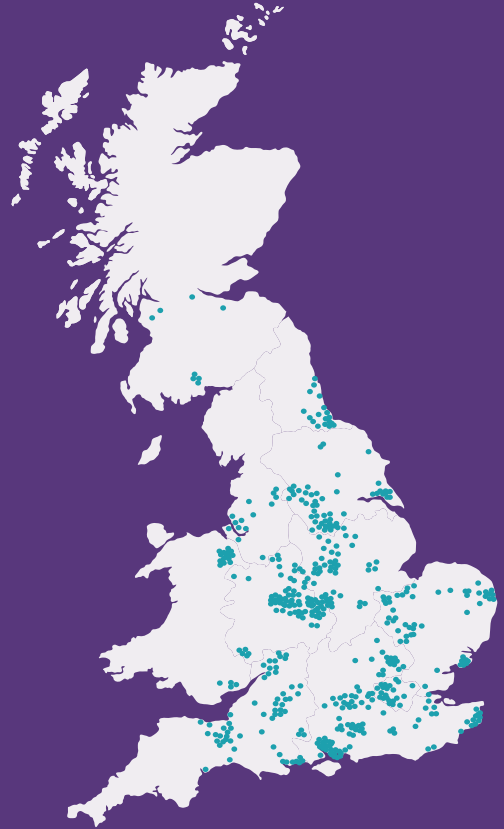
