Hibernia is a **residential care home** located in Bursledon, Southampton. We provide **support for up to five men** with autism, epilepsy, learning disabilities and challenging behaviour.

The people we support can enjoy a range of **communal areas**, including a lounge, kitchen, garden and sensory room.

Our home has one bedroom on the ground floor with a further four bedrooms on the first floor. All but one bedroom has **en-suite facilities** and there is a **shared bathroom** on the first floor.

**Adaptations** have been made to our home to ensure easy access for the people we support. We have **a ramp into our large garden**, so we can enjoy the outdoors!

Our team use a **range of communication methods**, such as the use of keywords, Makaton, photographs, objects of reference, and the Picture Exchange Communication System (PECS)!

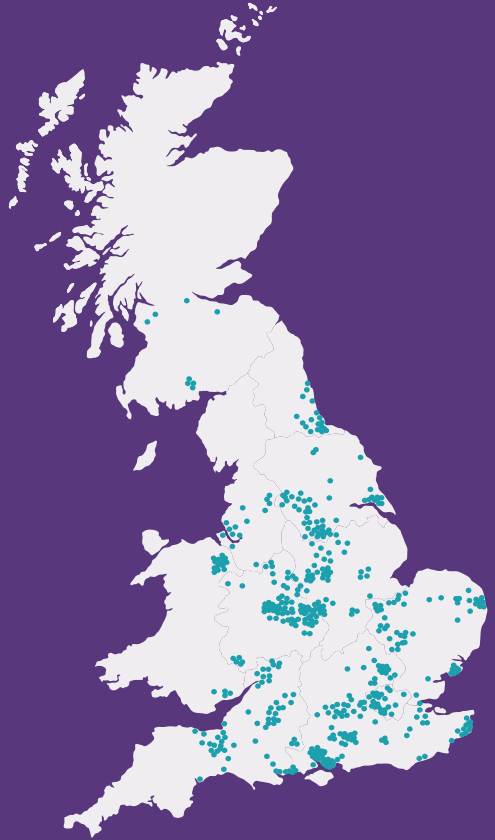
